

INITIAL RULES FOR PLAYING TWO GAMES PER DAY ON STAGECOACH FIELD 3 IN LIEU OF USING THE DIRT AND GRASS FIELD ON STAGECOACH FIELD 1

First game on Field 3

Batting practice cannot start until 8 am per City ordinance.

The first pitch of the first game on Field 3 will be at **8:30 am**, unless the Managers agree to an earlier start.

Managers can agree to an earlier start by eliminating or limiting the number of balls hit per player in BP.

The sooner games start, the more innings the teams can play.

Once the game starts, Managers and Umpires will maintain a quick pace to the game to try to play at least 7 innings. There is no guarantee that each game will go at least 7 innings in the time allotted, but we hope they will, and we also hope some games will go a full 9 innings.

No infield practice is allowed after the 1st inning.

The game will proceed **until 9:40 am**, plus an open inning **after 9:40 am**.

Managers will pick an official timekeeper for the game. At 9:40 am, if an inning is already underway, teams will complete that inning plus the open inning. If an inning is not already underway at 9:40 am, the next inning will be the open inning.

Teams must leave the field and dugouts immediately after the game ends so that BP can begin for the next game.

Second game on Field 3

The second game on Field 3 will begin at **approximately 10 am** with a BP before the game of no more than 10-hit-balls per player.

The game will start at **10:30 am**.

The game will be a regular 9 inning game.
